User Instructions for Solar Chargers

Thank you for renting the Solar Phone Charger from Rottnest Rentals! This rugged, outdoor-ready solar power bank is perfect for keeping your phone, camera, or other devices charged while exploring the beaches and paths of Rottnest Island.

With a high-capacity 20,000mAh battery, built-in solar panel, fast 18W PD charging, twin LED torch with SOS mode, and IP54 water/dust resistance, it's designed for reliable off-grid use.

These instructions incorporate the manufacturer's guidelines from NRG Vault (nrgvault.com.au) for safe and proper use, along with additional environmental considerations tailored to Rottnest Island's unique ecosystem.

Important: Read all instructions before use. Failure to follow them may result in injury, damage to the product, or environmental harm. This is a rental item—return it clean and undamaged to avoid fees.

SAFETY PECAUTIONS

Follow these guidelines to ensure a safe experience (per manufacturer warnings):

- Capacity: 20,000mAh lithium battery—can charge most smartphones 4-6 times or tablets 2-3 times (actual varies by device).
- Do not expose to extreme heat (e.g., leave in direct sun on hot surfaces >60°C or in a closed car), puncture, crush, or disassemble—risk of fire or explosion.
- Keep ports covered when not in use to prevent water/sand ingress (IP54 splash/dust resistant, not fully waterproof).
- Health Considerations: Avoid use if damaged or swollen. Do not use while swimming or in heavy rain.

General Warnings:

- Inspect for damage before use; report any issues to Rottnest Rentals immediately.
- Do not charge devices unattended overnight.
- For emergency torch/SOS: Double-press power button for modes—use responsibly.
- Manufacturer's Note: Built-in protections against overcharge, over-discharge, and short-circuit, but always handle lithium batteries with care.

Setup and Use

The NRG Vault arrives pre-charged and ready to use.

What's Included: Power bank with integrated solar panel, carry handle, protected ports (USB-C PD 18W, USB-A ports for up to 3 devices), twin LED torch/SOS.

Steps:

- 1. Press power button to check charge level (LED indicators).
- 2. Open rubber port cover and connect your device with the three way cable provided.
- 3. Press power button to start charging (auto-start on some models).

For solar charging: Place in direct sunlight (green indicator lights when charging)—ideal for topping up during the day.

Tips: Solar is for emergency/top-up (slow in low light); best to pre-charge via wall outlet. Keep ports covered after use.

Usage Guidelines

- Charging Devices: Perfect for phones, cameras, headphones during island activities like biking or beach time.
- On the Island:

- Use at Thomson Bay, The Basin, or trails to stay connected for photos, maps, or emergencies.
- Emergency ready with torch/SOS for low light or signalling.

Restrictions:

- Do not leave in direct hot sun unattended (e.g., on beach towel)—risk of overheating.
- Avoid exposure to saltwater immersion (rinse splashes immediately).

Environmental Considerations

Rottnest Island is a Class A Reserve with fragile ecosystems, including seagrass meadows, marine life, and native wildlife. As a renter, you play a role in protecting it:

- No Littering: Secure cables and device to prevent loss. Take all rubbish to shore bins.
- Wildlife Respect: Do not approach or feed quokkas, seals, or birds. Keep 10m distance from animals.
- Habitat Protection: Place on stable surfaces away from dunes/vegetation. Use solar feature responsibly to reduce reliance on grid power.

Sustainability: Carefully wipe with a clean cloth after sandy/salty use to remove debris, prolonging life.

Cleaning and Packing

Steps:

- 1. Disconnect all cables and close port cover securely.
- 2. Wipe down with damp cloth; rinse gently with fresh water if sandy/salty (avoid submerging).
- 3. Dry thoroughly before packing.

Tips: Manufacturer recommends keeping clean and dry for longevity.

Maintenance and Return

• Return to Rottnest Rentals: Return by 4:00pm. Inspect for damage; fees apply for tears, excessive dirt, or loss (e.g., \$50 cleaning fee, full replacement cost for unrepairable damage). Report any issues upon return.
